

- Students begin their introduction to Spanish by focusing on the four key areas of foreign language study: listening, speaking, reading, and writing. The course represents an ideal blend of language learning pedagogy. Each lesson consists of a new vocabulary theme and grammar concept, some with reading and listening activities. Speaking and writing activities, cultural presentations and practices are included to reinforce vocabulary and grammar. There is emphasis on providing conversational examples for the language concepts presented in each lesson. Students should expect to be actively engaged in their own language learning, become familiar with common vocabulary terms and phrases, comprehend a wide range of grammar patterns, participate in simple conversations and respond appropriately to basic conversational prompts. Experienced native Spanish instructor will lead this class.
